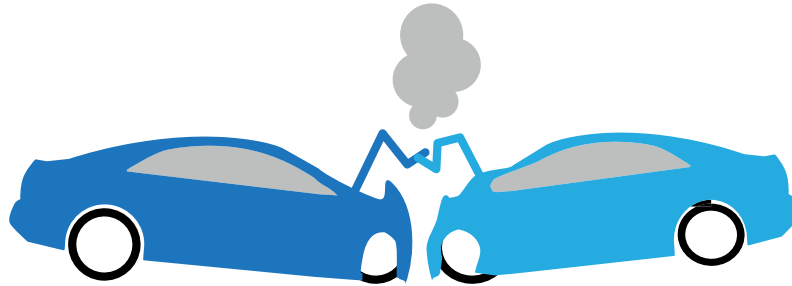
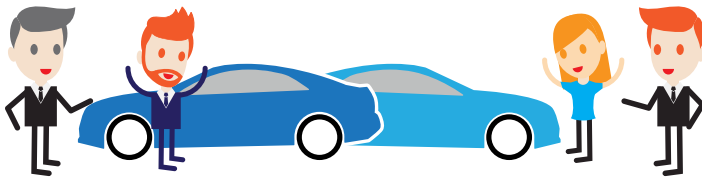

DO NOT LEAVE THE SCENE

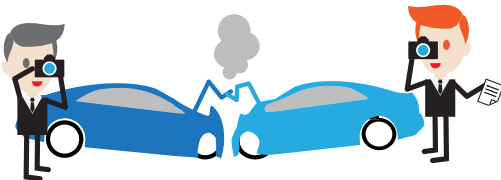


of the accident until you have exchanged contact

Do NOT discuss who is at fault with other parties.
Do NOT disclose your policy details. You should
only share your driver's license number and
insurance information.

TAKE PHOTOS

of the scene and cars
(including license plates)



CALL THE POLICE

and follow their instructions.

CALL 911 if there are any injuries.

In minor accidents, the police may instruct you to
exchange information and then contact your insurance
company.
